If you are concerned about your Child's condition... For Example • • •

- Not fitting in with group activities
- Restlessness and a short attention span.
- Having many troubles with friends
- Unclear pronunciation and concerns about stuttering
- Not responding when spoken nearby, concerns about hearing
- Concerns about the way things are seen, such as bringing faces close to objects
- Concerns that development may not be progressing at a typical pace
- Those considering enrollment, advancement, or transfer to special support classes or special support schools
- Those who require medical care and need to have medical staff, such as nurses, assigned to the school
- Those planning to enroll in elementary school and seeking guidance in special support classrooms or resource rooms.
- ** Elementary and middle school students enrolled in regular classes should apply through their school. Please consult with the school where you are enrolled.
- Those who have been recommended to consult about transferring schools by their current school.

The Procedure of School Consultations

[Mid-May onwards: Accepting consultations.]

Prior telephone reservation of the visit reception date and time is required.

Interviews and hearings will be held at the Meguro Ward General Government Building.

- The classes for autism, emotional disorders, and physical disabilities have an enrollment deadline.
- We will send you application forms, filling instructions, consultation guidelines, etc. before your visit to the office.
- <The following documents will be required>
- Developmental test

If you are unable to provide the developmental assessment results at the time of application, please submit them to the School Support Committee two weeks prior.

- ・A copy of your physical disability certificate towards or Ai no Techou Handbook "愛の手帳" (for those who own it).
- A copy of Boshi Kenkou techou Handbook "母子健康手帳" (for those who own it).
- Medical examination records, etc. (for those who wish to apply for special support classes for autism / emotional disorders and special support classes for physical disabilities).

(Pre-observation of behavior) (Only for the relevant individuals.)

 Observation of kindergarten, nursery schools, daycares, and rehabilitation facilities, etc. (requested by the Board of Education to the respective facilities).

[From July onwards: Implementation and participation in the School Support Committee]

• Conducting interviews and behavioral observations with parents and their children.

• Consideration regarding learning environments that maximize potential, involving specialists in education, medicine, psychology, etc.

[Notification of the outcome from the School Support Committee]

 Approximately 2 weeks later, you will receive a written statement. (If necessary, a meeting will be arranged)

[Trial of special support classes or special support schools.]

- Will be implemented as needed.
- The school counselor will arrange the schedule and accompany as needed.

[Decision of the School Enrollment]

We respect the preferences of the child and the parents, and make decisions through agreement with the Board of Education. We also consider providing necessary support based on educational needs and reasonable accommodations.

[Mid-December onwards: Sending out enrollment notifications]

Enrollment in Meguro Ward public schools

- Regular Classrooms
- Regular classrooms and special support classrooms
- Regular classrooms and itinerant support classrooms (for hearing and speech)
- Special support classes (for intellectual disabilities, physical disabilities, autism/emotional disorders)

Enrollment in special education schools

(public or private)

- Enrollment in municipal, private, national special education schools, etc. (for visual impairment, hearing impairment, intellectual disabilities, physical disabilities, etc.)
- If the School Support Committee determines enrollment in a special education school, and the individual wishes to enroll in a municipal special education school, this matter will be referred to the Tokyo Metropolitan Board of Education for further consultation."

Regarding School Trials & Visits

- Please visit during the school open days of each school. For schedules, please check the respective school's website.
- For special support classes in elementary schools (for intellectual disabilities, autism/emotional disorders), we plan to hold an open house events at the beginning of the academic year. Please contact the Education Support Division's School Enrollment Consultation Section for inquiries.
- For visits to special education schools, please check each school's website and apply directly to the respective school.
- We do not offer visits or hands on experiences or trial class to special support classrooms.

≪Special Support Classroom≫

 They are set up within each school and allow students to receive instruction in social skills and other subjects in a separate classroom for part of the time.

«Special need support classrooms» (for hearing and speech)

 It is set up within Higashine Elementary School and aims to improving issues related to hearing and speech.

«Special Support Classes»

- Special support classes for intellectual disabilities are established at Yakumo Elementary School, Sugakari Elementary School, Ishibumi Elementary School, Takaban Elementary School, Otori Junior High School and Meguro nisi Junior High.
- Special support classes for physical disabilities are located at Aburamen Elementary School and Otori Junior High School(facility located within Aburamen Elementary School).
- Special support classes for autism and emotional disorders are established at Gohonogi Elementary School and Meguro Chuo Middle School, primarily targeting children with selective mutism.
