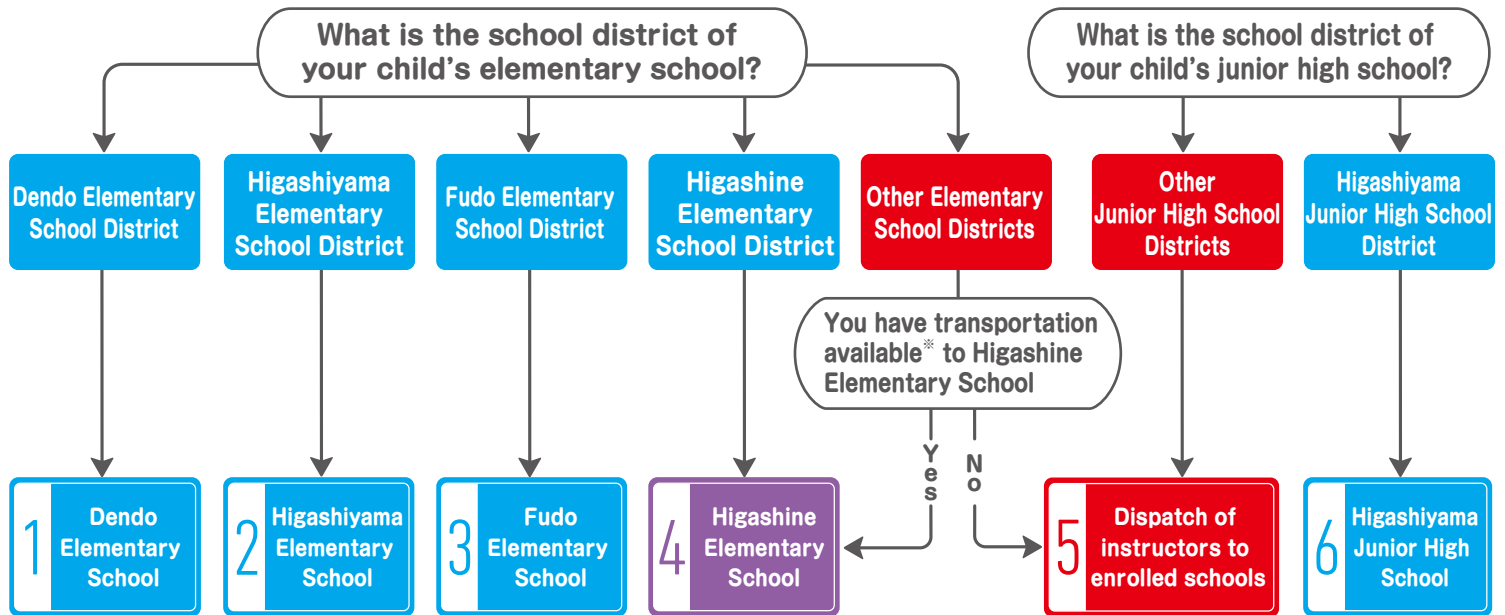

Meguro Japanese Language Class Guide

Depending on your home address and your child's age, there are following options.



※It is necessary for parents / guardians, or someone equivalent (such as a pick up/drop off service person appointed by parents / guardians) to use public transportation to drop off/pick up their child at the Japanese Language International Class in Higashine Elementary School.

1 Dendo Elementary School

School District Nakameguro 4-chome (7-10), Mita 1-chome (whole area), Mita 2-chome (whole area), Meguro 1-chome (whole area), Meguro 2-chome (1-3, 13-15), Meguro 3-chome (1-3)

Features Many of the children here have multilingual/multicultural backgrounds and participate in cultural exchange activities while experiencing Japanese culture and traditions.

2 Higashiyama Elementary School

School District Higashiyama 1-chome (1-2, 10-15, 22-25, 30-35 Ban), Higashiyama 2-chome (whole area), Higashiyama 3-chome (whole area), Ohashi 2-chome (24), Kamimeguro 5-chome (1-4, 13-17, 20-25, 31-33)

Features Many children here have overseas experiences or multilingual/multicultural backgrounds. Japanese language and subject lessons are provided to help them adapt to school life.

3 Fudo Elementary School

School District Shimomeguro 4-chome (whole area), Shimomeguro 5-chome (whole area), Shimomeguro 6-chome (whole area), Meguro-honcho 1-chome (whole area)

Features New Japanese language class started in 2025.

4 Japanese Language International Class in Higashine Elementary School

School District Kakinokizaka 2-chome (whole area), Kakinokizaka 3-chome (whole area), Yakumo 4-chome (whole area), Yakumo 5-chome (whole area), Higashigaoka 1-chome (whole area), Higashigaoka 2-chome (whole area)

Features Children have opportunities to participate in art exhibitions and study presentations.

5 Dispatch of instructors to enrolled schools

Class Schedule Once or twice a week (2 hours per session)

Features The coordinator assesses the child's Japanese language ability and assigns an instructor. We have an agreement with Waseda University, where professional knowledge and teaching experience are applied for thorough instruction.

6 Higashiyama Junior High School

School District Aobadai 1-chome, 22-23, 30, Higashiyama (entire area), Ohashi 2-chome, 24, Kamimeguro 1-chome, 16-22, Kamimeguro 2-chome, 46-49, Kamimeguro 3-chome, 1-3, Kamimeguro 3-chome, 6-44, Kamimeguro 5-chome (entire area)

Features Twice a year, a meeting is held for the parents of child with foreign background, offering opportunities for parents to join discussions and share information about child's career paths.
